- Are you a voluntary, community and social enterprise organisation (VCSE) delivering frontline services? Eligible organisations can apply for the cost and delivery of an independent energy assessment to help identify energy-saving opportunities in their building, and then following the assessment, for a capital grant towards the cost of installing the energy efficiency measures recommended. The first round of capital grants has now closed with the next round opening in April and a final round in July. The scheme is funded as part of a package of over £100 million of support being delivered by the Government to help frontline delivery organisations with the increased cost of living. With a dedicated apprenticeship levy fund of £2.7 million for Oxfordshire, we are reaching out to all SMEs currently considering or planning to hire an apprentice to encourage them to make use of this funding.

It's important to note that through an apprenticeship levy transfer, your business is exempt from paying the co-investment fee. This means significant financial savings as the support is already pre-funded; thus, there is no cost to your business.
